## Voice Choices $\mid$ Best in Show

## David Row

Row's recent series of abstract paintings, "Demons in Paradise," range from roughly four to seven feet on a side and share undulating curves of varying transparency in closely tuned colors: reds over oranges. whites partially obscuring grays. Filled with allusions (the overlapping shapes writhe like a mass of serpents: titles include Tantrum and Memento Mori), these compositions gain energy from overlapping paint layers and vigorous brushwork that sometimes form lushly smooth arcs, and other times cast off splatters like sparks from a grinding wheel.
